Introduction

Canyonlands Computer Consulting is committed to respecting our clients' and visitors' privacy both on the Internet and off and recognize our users' need for appropriate protection and management of any personally identifiable information ("Personal Information") that is shared with us.

Canyonlands Computer Consulting has established this Privacy Policy so that users can understand the care with which we intend to treat their Personal Information.

Personal Information means any information that may be used to identify an individual, including, but not limited to, a first and last name, a home or other physical address, a phone number, and an email address, or other contact information. Canyonlands Computer Consulting may also collect demographic information about its clients and website visitors including but not limited to a visitors or clients age, gender, and personal interests or preferences, and also considers this to be Personal Information.

How Does Canyonlands Computer Consulting Collect Personal Information?

Canyonlands Computer Consulting collects personal information in three ways:

1. Through information provided directly with the consent of our clients and site visitors.
2. From information collected through web server logs and other statistical software.
3. Through user-sessions by clients and visitors to our website.

Information Provided by Our Clients and Website Visitors

Canyonlands Computer Consulting will not collect any personally-identifiable information about you, such as your name, address, telephone number or email address (see "Personal Information" above) through its website unless you provide it to us yourself.

When we do collect Personal Information that you provide to us, we may store, process and use it for the following purposes:

1. To contact you directly regarding inquiries about our company.
2. To send you information you have requested including information about our services, our prices, and so forth.
3. To better understand your needs and how we can improve our products and services to meet those needs.
4. To fulfill client orders and complete the purchase process.
5. To provide our clients with technical and website assistance.

Information from Web Server Logs and Statistical Software

Canyonlands Computer Consulting records and saves information about you from our web server logs and statistical software such as your Internet [Protocol] (IP) address, the time of day you visited our site, the pages you visited, and your browser type. This information is used to verify our records and to provide better services to our visitors and clients.



Information from User-Sessions

In order to offer and provide you with personalized services, or to verify your identity during the purchase of our services, Canyonlands Computer Consulting may use "sessions" to store and help track your Personal Information. A session is a piece of data that identifies you as a unique user. Canyonlands Computer Consulting will not disclose its session data to third parties except as required by a valid legal process such as a search warrant, subpoena, statute, or court order.

Protection of Children's Personal Information

Canyonlands Computer Consulting is committed to protecting the online privacy of children and making the Internet safe. It is our policy not to gather any personal data on our website that is directed at children. If age information is gathered on our website it is never intentionally directed at children, as it is our policy not to collect personal data from children under 13.

We encourage parents/guardians of children under 13 to regularly check and monitor their children's use of email, website visitation, and other activities online.

Personal Information Disclosure Policy

Canyonlands Computer Consulting will not willfully disclose any individually identifiable information about you to any third party without first receiving your permission, except in the cases listed below. We do not sell, trade, lease, loan or rent any personal information to outside organizations or individuals at any time.

Personal Information Disclosure Exceptions

1. When we have requested and received your consent to share information.
2. When we have to share information for a product or service you have requested.
3. When we are required by law to disclose details to the appropriate authorities in the event of an ongoing criminal investigation, a court order, or in legal proceedings.
4. When we are ordered to comply with legal proceedings against Canyonlands Computer Consulting.
5. When it is determined that we need to protect and defend the rights or property of Canyonlands Computer Consulting or act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of clients of Canyonlands Computer Consulting or website visitors and members of the general public.

Protecting Your Information

While Canyonlands Computer Consulting is committed to protecting your personal information, no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. Therefore, users are solely responsible for maintaining the secrecy of any passwords you set up and/or any account information. Please see our **Terms of Service** for more information.

Some of your personal information may be especially sensitive, therefore information that you send to us on this website is transmitted over secure Internet connections using SSL (Secure Sockets Layer) 256 bit encryption services, which are enabled by Thawte Inc., and which is the currently accepted standard for online security. We have been trained to appropriately secure all personal information we receive, including information previously received and contained in our database. Further, we require password authentication from any third party that you have authorized to receive your information.
